# **Conviction: So What?**

• Where does Colossians fit?

- As a short epistle, Colossians is full of rich theology, clear application, and personal connection. We learn a lot about the "Pauline Circle" at the end of the book.

- Colossians is a deeply theological letter that is written to a church that is being threatened with teaching that diminishes the supremacy and sufficiency of Christ.

- Colossians presents perhaps Paul's most lofty presentation of Christology.
- Colossians also presents the clear application of a high Christology to daily living.
- What should we believe?
- Jesus Christ is God and nothing less.
- In Him we have all we need.
- How should we behave?
- Cancel your quest for more rituals.
- Cancel your quest for more knowledge.
- Cancel your quest for more experiences.
- Cancel your quest for more rules.
