




Ash Wednesday





Most importantly, the arrival of the presence of God incarnate in Jesus of Nazareth constitutes and embodies the arrival of the kingdom. In a theological sense, God's relational presence precedes, creates, and signifies the kingdom - no presence, no kingdom."


And he began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes and be killed, and after three days rise again.
