Leader commitment:

- A year of praying, listening, challenging, and encouraging my Home Church.
- Ensure every week of each HC term we will meet, whether 2 couples or 8 can be there.
- Will rely on the Holy Spirit for every challenge that comes up through the year.
- Pray for our HC, Fellowship, the staff of Fellowship, and the elders of Fellowship.

Member commitment:

- To be present and prepared (having attended the Sunday worship service or listened to the podcast) each of the 11 weeks of the first term of Home Church, unless something unexpected (sickness, traffic jam, work, or natural disaster) happens. Commitment to one another in these two areas (over time) will help foster great relationships.
- Pray for our HC, Fellowship, the staff of Fellowship, and the elders of Fellowship.
