The LIFE Pathway - How to be Blessed in a Trial (1:12)

- Endurance
- Approval
- Crown of LIFE

The Blame Game - No One but Yourself (1:13)

- “God made me do it.”
- “The devil made me do it.”
- “I did it.”

The DEATH Pathway - How to Fail in Misery (1:14-15)

- Lust
- Sin
- DEATH

The Credit Game - No One but God

- Don't fool yourself.
- God is a consistent giver of good gifts.
- Salvation is the first fruits with more to come.

**Trials provide an opportunity to really live
when you endure and experience God's approval
or experience living death as a Christian
when your desire leads to sin and ultimately death.**
