God Interprets the King's Dream

(Daniel 2:1-49)

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream (2:1-16).

- Without the Lord people look for guidance in crazy places (2:1-4).
- Without the Lord there is no hope for reliable guidance (2:5-11).
- With the Lord guidance can be found and disaster avoided (2:12-16).

Only the Lord is a reliable source of guidance and peace.

Thriving in Babylon: See and confess the bankruptcy of your own efforts.

Daniel's Prayer (2:17-30).

- God's people seek Him in troubling times (2:17-18).
- God's people praise him for his provisions and protection (2:19-23).
- God's people know that God alone controls and reveals history (2:24-30).

Prayer and praise is the right response to our need and God's provision.

Thriving in Babylon: Look to God for wisdom and praise Him when He gives it.

Daniel's Interpretation (2:31-49).

- God reveals the fragility of human kingdoms (2:31-35).
- A succession of kingdoms will rise and fall until God's eternal kingdom comes
 (2:36-45).
- YHWH is the God of God and Lord of Kings who reveals His plans and promotes His people (2:46-49).

The culmination of history is the eternal kingdom of God.

Thriving in Babylon: Keep your eyes on Jesus who is the King of the king of kings.

God's people can look to Him for guidance and praise Him as the source of power and wisdom, which brings peace, because He will establish His eternal kingdom.
