- The bible is inspired by God and has no errors.
- God is Trinity. One God in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
- God is sovereign and He does not change
- Jesus is God and was born of a virgin. He lived a sinless life, died on the cross in our place and was raised to life on the third day.
- The Holy Spirit is God and every believer is indwelt and gifted by Him.
- Jesus is the only way of salvation.
- Salvation is by grace through faith in the finished work of Christ.
- All true believers are eternally secure and cannot lose their salvation
- All believers should be making disciples and global mission is important.
- God's design for marriage is one man and one woman for life.
- God does miracles but they are not normative. Speaking in tongues is not encouraged.
