



Idolatry has always been and is now a snare for God's people.

The angel of the Lord went up from Gilgal to Bokim and said, "I brought you up out of Egypt and led you into the land I swore to give to your ancestors.

I said, 'I will never break my covenant with you, and you shall not make a covenant with the people of this land, but you shall break down their altars.' Yet you have disobeyed me. Why have you done this?

And I have also said, 'I will not drive them out before you; they will become traps for you, and their gods will become snares to you.'"

God is always faithful to His covenant;
He will bless and discipline

God will use persecution and oppression to turn His children back to Him.

We bring the consequences of idolatry upon ourselves.

Idolatry is any priority
that is greater than
worshipping the Lord fully.

ldolatry usually looks like we are simply fitting into the world's value system.

Therefore I exhort you, brothers, through the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, so that you may approve what is the good and well-pleasing and perfect will of God.
