

And Yahweh descended in the cloud, and he stood with him there, and he proclaimed the name of Yahweh.




Proclaimed the Name of Yahweh (וַיִּקְרָא בְשֵׁם יְהוָה)

Here is one of the clearest examples of what it means "to call on the name of the Lord," as that clause has been translated traditionally. It seems more likely that it means "to make proclamation of Yahweh by name." It is literally "calling out His name or attributes." Yahweh came down and made a proclamation—and the next verses give the content of what he said. It is a proclamation of the nature or attributes of God (which is what his "name" means throughout the Bible). When Yahweh is doing this it is proclaiming, when we do this it can be proclamation, preaching, or praise.



And Yahweh passed over before him, and he proclaimed, "Yahweh, Yahweh, God, who is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding with loyal love and faithfulness, keeping loyal love to the thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and he does not leave utterly unpunished, punishing the guilt of fathers on sons and on sons of sons on third and fourth generations."
