Ephesians 6:10-20 is both a Summary & Conclusion to the Book of Ephesians

BE STRONG IN THE LORD (6:10)

- Be strong ($\delta UV \alpha \mu i \varsigma$) Transforming Power
- in the strength (κραται) Overcoming Resistance Power
- of His might (ισχυος) Inherent Power/Strength

PUT ON THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD (6:11a)

- Put on: Actively depend on resources not your own
- Full Armor of God: God's fully adequate resources for battle

SO THAT YOU CAN STAND (6:11b-12)

- Purpose: To stand ($\sigma\tau\eta\nu\alpha\iota)$ Stand Your ground in the Battle

His Strategies ($\mu\epsilon\thetao\delta\iota\alpha\varsigma$) schemes, tricks, wiles

Our Opponents:

- 1. Powerful
- 2. Evil
- 3. Clever
- 4. Defeated

THE BATTLE IS AGAINST FALSE DOCTRINE

- Satan is a liar (John 8:44).
- Satan attacks our theology (Genesis 3:1-7).

THE BATTLE IS PERSONAL

- We (παλη) "wrestle."
- This is armor for close combat.

THE BATTLE IS COMMUNAL

- The imperatives are plural.
- We stand "together."

THE BATTLE IS DEFENSIVE

- Stay on your feet.
- Jesus is the victor.

THE BATTLE IS RELENTLESS

- Stand, Stand, Stand, Stand!
- Resist "in the evil day."

THE BATTLE IS ALREADY WON

- God is our divine warrior.
- Remember we are blessed in the "heavenly places" (Eph. 1:3)

THE BELT OF TRUTH

Because God is true and faithful, *I can live with integrity*. **THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS**

Because God is holy and perfect,

I can live righteously.

THE SHOES OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE

Because God makes peace and establishes peace,

I can live secure in my relationships.

THE SHIELD OF FAITH

Because God is generous and protective, I can live with utter dependance on God.

THE HELMET OF SALVATION

Because God is gracious and wise,

I can live with confidence in the battle.

THE SWORD OF THE SPIRIT

Because God's will is clear and consistent, I can apply His word to my life situations.

The Christian's Conflict (Ephesians 6:18-20) *"Warfare Prayer"*



And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people (NIV).

Ephesians: A Little Bit of Context

"Pray in the Spirit."

- Prayer is prompted by the Holy Spirit.
- Prayer is guided by the Holy Spirit.

"Pray on all Occasions."

- Prayer is a *conversation* with God throughout the day.
- Prayer is a *way of life*. Everything you do can be prayer.

"Pray with all kinds of prayers and requests."

- Prayer is a multifaceted communication with God.
- Prayer is asking for God to accomplish *His purpose* and provide for us.

"Be alert and keep on praying."

- Prayer keeps you alert. Alertness keeps you praying.
- *Persistent* prayer is powerful prayer.

"Pray for the Lord's people."

- Pray for your community.
- Pray for the Lost.
- Pray for effective evangelism (6:19-20).
