JUDGES: A Faithful God in a Broken World "Samson: A Wild Man Finds a Wife (?)" (Judges 14:1-20)

Samson and the Greeks

Entitled

Even though God's grace can be misused and turned into entitlement God is always at work accomplishing His Purposes.

(14:1-4)

Empowered

God's power is the true source of every triumph.

(14:5-7)

Intrigued

Subtle disobedience is significant and often has an impact on others around you.

(14:8-9)

Entertained

When our own self-interest and amusement dominate our world-view chaotic consequences are a frequent result.

(14:10-18)

Enraged

God will always accomplish His purpose while we will reap what we sow.

(14:19-20)

The grace of God allows Him to use us for His purposes in spite of our shortcomings (but not without consequences).

Next Steps

- Truth: God's sovereign purposes will always be accomplished-often in spite of us.
- Warning: Our selfish entitlement and petulant preoccupation with entertainment will eventually come home to roost.
- Challenge: Aline yourself with the purposes of God.

Our Home Churches meet weekly to facilitate quicker relational depth, study the same passage taught Sunday to help apply Scripture in the context of community, and pray with one another. *Home Church helps our body seek God's best for one another.*

Home Church Questions

- Read <u>Judges 14:1-20.</u>
- What stands out in this passage or from the message?
- Talk about the family dynamics in the passage. How does this impact the story? How have family dynamics impacted your story?
- This passage really begins to reveal Samson's character. How would you describe him? Do you know anyone like him?
- How are people like Samson (whatever that means to you) viewed in our culture?
- There is a real tension in this passage between God accomplishing His purposes (esp. verses 4, 6, 19) and Samson's lack of faithfulness to God's law and his own Nazarite vow. Talk about that.
- In 1985 Neil Postman provided a significant analysis and critique of our modern culture in his book, Amusing Ourselves to Death. Reflect on the title of the book and discuss how this has proved to be true since 1985 (interestingly the Apple Macintosh—I am using one to type these notes— was introduced in 1984).
- How do you handle the fact that Samson is clearly not a spiritually mature man and yet "The Spirit of the Lord came upon him in power" (vv. 6, 19). What lesson might we learn from this? Is there a caution here with what we do to religious celebrities?
