Friday – Jesus' crucifixion and death







Christ's Incarnation




“Look! The virgin will




Through Christ's incarnation we






Through Christ's ministry we

the foal of a donkey.”



highest!”



“Hosanna-is an Aramaic expression that literally means, “help, I pray,” or “save, I pray.”




And in Hebrew, “O Lord, save”


