- A beautiful expression of a heart of worship throughout life.

- What should we believe?
- God is great, and God is good.
- God is active in our lives as He has been throughout history.
- God can handle our hearts when we cry "out of the depths."
- How should we behave?
- Descriptive Praise: Praise God for Who He is.
- Declarative Praise: Praise God for what He has done.
- Lament: Praise God for what He will do even when you don't see it.

- Reorient yourself to what God has done with Declarative Praise.
