(Romans 8:33)

Freedom:

Who is He that condemns?
Christ's death and resurrection qualifies Him to advocate for us!
(Romans 8:34)

Security:

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Nothing can ever separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus! (Romans 8:35-39)
