What then shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us?

Romans 8:31

Protection:

Who can be against us?

And God said, “I will be with you. And this will be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain.”

Exodus 3:12

Protection:

Who can be against us?

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Isaiah 41:10

Protection

Provision:

Will He not graciously give us all things?

He who did not spare His own Son,
but gave Him up for us all — how will
He not also, along with Him, graciously
give us all things?

Romans 8:32

Provision:

Will He not graciously give us all things?

“Do not lay a hand on the boy,” he said.

“Do not do anything to him. Now I know that you fear God, because you have not withheld from me your son, your only son.”

Genesis 22:12

Provision:

Will He not graciously give us all things?

Abraham looked up and there in a thicket he saw a ram caught by its horns. He went over and took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering instead of his son. So Abraham called that place The Lord Will Provide. And to this day it is said, “On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided.”

Provision:

Will He not graciously give us all things?

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:16

Provision:

Will He not graciously give us all things?

But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:8

Provision:

Will He not graciously give us all things?

This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

1 John 4:10

Provision

God's grace will always supply
our needs!

Acquittal:

Who shall bring any charge against God's elect?

Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies.

Romans 8:33

Acquittal:

Who shall bring any charge against God's elect?

He who vindicates me is near. Who then will bring charges against me? Let us face each other! Who is my accuser? Let him confront me! It is the Sovereign lord who helps me. Who is he that will condemn me? They will all wear out like a garment; the moths will eat them up.

Isaiah 50:8-9

Acquittal:

Who shall bring any charge against God's elect?

Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand.

Romans 5:1-2

Acquittal:

Who shall bring any charge against God's elect?

But now He has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in His sight, without blemish and free from accusation...

Colossians 1:22

Acquittal

God has already declared us
righteous in His sight!

Freedom:

Who is he that condemns?

Who is He that condemns? Christ Jesus, who died - more than that, who was raised to life - is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.

Romans 8:34

Freedom:

Who is he that condemns?

Christ's death and resurrection
conquered sin and overcame the grave.

Romans 8:34

Freedom:

Who is he that condemns?

Christ is seated at the right hand of God which demonstrates His supremacy, His authority to save and His reigning position.

Christ is interceding for us shows that
He is our Heavenly Advocate and our
High Priest.

Freedom:

Who is he that condemns?

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus, the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:1-2

With this Christ as our Saviour (who died, was raised, has been exalted and is interceding), we know that 'there is now no condemnation' for those who are United to him. We can therefore confidently challenge the universe, with all its inhabitants human and demonic:

Who is he that condemns? There will never be an answer.
